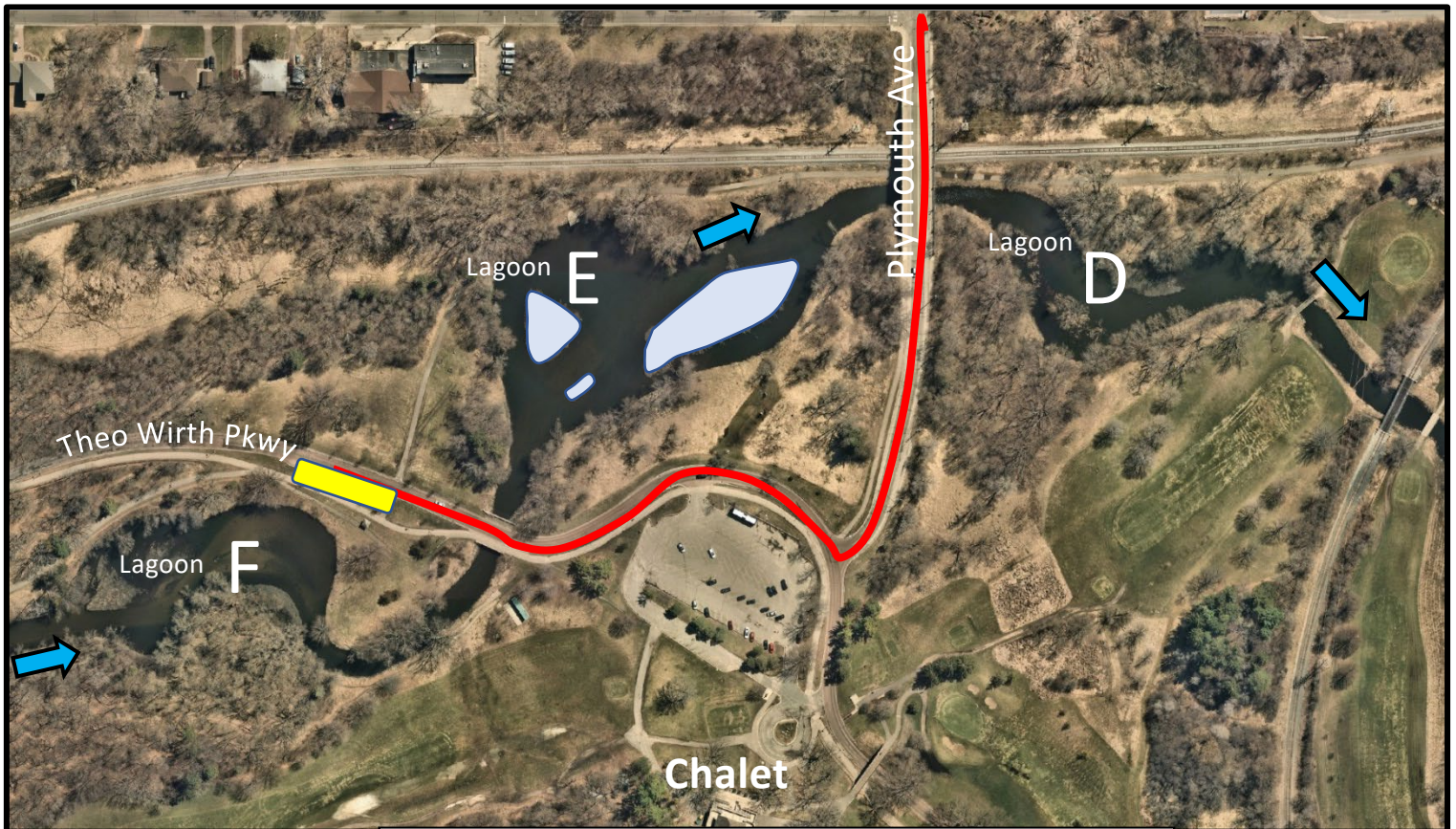






Construction News

Bassett Creek Lagoon Dredging Project Theodore Wirth Regional Park November 2022 – March 2023

The Bassett Creek Watershed Management Commission is implementing a project to remove accumulated sediment (including small islands that formed from deposited sediment) from Lagoons D, E, and F in the park in order to improve water quality and aquatic habitats. Construction equipment such as backhoes and dump trucks will be dredging the lagoons and hauling the contaminated sediment to licensed facilities.

No significant trail closures are anticipated and no parking lots will be impacted. See map below for construction area, haul routes, and impacted roads and trails.
