LGU Findings and Conclusions (attach additional sheets as necessary):

On behalf of Kerby Skurat, Anderson Engineering submitted a joint application form requesting a no-loss approval for temporary wetland impacts located within the property at 1143 South Shore Drive in the City of Medicine Lake, Section 36, Township 118N, Range 22W, within Hennepin County.

After unpermitted wetland impacts occurred in April 2016, Anderson Engineering conducted a wetland delineation, which was approved by the BCWMC on 5/31/16 as a Type 3/6, PEM/SS1Cd, shallow marsh/shrub-carr wetland. A restoration plan was also submitted by Anderson Engineering. Both the wetland delineation and the restoration plan were reviewed by TEP members.

An initial site review was conducted on 4/14/16 with Ben Meyer from the Board of Water and Soil Resources, Brad Scheib with HKGI for the City of Medicine Lake, Kerby Skurat, Karen Wold with Barr Engineering for the BCWMC, Melissa Jenny with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and Kate Drewry with the MN Department of Natural Resources. After initial restoration was conducted, another site review took place on 5/9/16 with Ben Meyer, Stacey Lijewski with Hennepin County, Karen Wold, Ben Hodapp and Lucy Kozub with Anderson Engineering for the applicant.

The wetland delineation report, wetland restoration plan, and survey were reviewed and discussed during the 5/19/16 BCWMC meeting. During the BCWMC meeting, the commissioners required the landowner to submit a joint application form requesting a no-loss approval for the temporary wetland impacts that were associated with the unpermitted wetland fill as well as recording a Declaration of Restrictions and Covenants on the wetland. The no-loss application and Declaration of Restrictions and Covenants were

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submitted to the LGU on 6/29/16. After review, changes were requested to the application, survey, and Declaration with revisions submitted on 7/25/16. After further review and comment, the Declaration and Restrictions of Covenants was again revised and was recorded on 8/16/16.

The unpermitted wetland fill area has been restored. The BCWMC approves the no-loss for temporary impacts. The Notice of Decision for the wetland delineation approval, and the final versions of the restoration plan, the no-loss application, and the recorded Declaration of Restrictions and Covenants are included with this Notice of Decision.






RESTORATION PLAN 1143 South Shore Dr. Medicine Lake, MN

RECITALS

- A. The Declarant holds the fee title or perpetual easement on the real property described in Exhibit A, attached hereto.
- B. A portion of this real property consists of an existing Wetland. Exhibit B, attached hereto, is a map or survey of the subject property with the approved Wetland boundary, as documented in the Bassett Creek Watershed Management Commission Notice of Decision dated May 31, 2016.
- C. The Local Government Unit (LGU) charged with WCA administration for the wetland located on this property is the Bassett Creek Watershed Management Commission (C/O Karen Wold at Barr Engineering), whose address is 4300 MarketPointe Drive, Suite 200, Minneapolis, MN 55435. All references in this instrument to Minnesota Statutes and Rules are to the Statutes and Rules currently in effect and as amended or renumbered in the future.

RESTRICTIONS AND COVENANTS

The Declarant makes the following declaration of restrictions and covenants for the Wetland on this property. These restrictions and covenants shall run with the land, and bind Declarant, and Declarant's heirs, successors, and assigns:

1. The Declarant agrees to protect the Wetland in perpetuity as required by the LGU and the State of Minnesota. Declarant shall not make any use of the Wetland that would adversely affect the existing functions or values of the Wetland as determined by the LGU and/or Minnesota Rules, Chapter 8420.

- 2. The Declarant shall not place any materials, substances, or other objects, nor erect or construct any type of structure, temporary or permanent within the Wetland without a permit or approval.
- 3. Declarant shall record or file this Declaration with the Hennepin County Recorder or Registrar of Titles, pay all costs associated with recording or filing, and provide proof of recording or filing to the LGU in order to be valid.
- 4. Acknowledge that this Declaration shall be unlimited in duration, without being re-recorded.
 - 5. This Declaration may be modified only by the written approval of the LGU.
 - 6. This Declaration may be enforced, at law or in equity, by the LGU.
