LGU Findings and Conclusions (attach additional sheets as necessary):

On behalf of LLW Partners, LLC, Kjolhaug Environmental Services Company, Inc. submitted a wetland delineation report for the property at 10715 South Shore Drive in the City of Medicine Lake, Section 25, Township 118N, Range 22W, within Hennepin County.

One wetland was delineated within the site boundaries and classified as a Type 3 PEM1C shallow marsh wetland.

The wetland delineation report and joint application form were provided to TEP members on 7/8/16 along with a Notice of Application and 15-business day comment period. The comment period ended on 8/2/16 and no comments were received.

A site review of the wetland delineation was conducted on 7/27/16. Present at the site review were Karen Wold with Barr Engineering for the BCWMC and Adam Cameron with Kjolhaug Environmental for the applicant. During the site review, some adjustments to the wetland boundary were requested moving the boundary slightly upslope in a few areas. On 7/29/16, Kjolhaug submitted a revised wetland delineation figure showing these edited boundaries. The revised wetland delineation figure is included in this Notice of Decision.

The revised wetland boundary and the wetland type were found to be accurate, based on the requirements of the 1987 USACE Wetland Delineation Manual, the 2010 Midwest Regional Supplement, and the 2015 Guidance for Submittal of Delineation Reports to the USACE and WCA LGU in Minnesota, Version 2.0. The BCWMC approves the wetland boundary and type.

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



Figure 1 - Site Location




Figure 2 - Existing Conditions
