GHD identified 6 basins at 4700 Nathan Lane in Plymouth, MN (Section 12, T118N, R22W). Basin W1 is DNR Public Water 580W and a Type 3,4,5 shallow open water marsh, floodplain forest, hardwood swamp, and wet meadow dominated by box elder, reed canary grass, and clearweed. Basin W2 is proposed as non-jurisdictional and is a floodplain forest dominated by black willow, box elder, buckthorn, reed canary grass, riverbank grape, and virginia creeper. Basin P1 is a PUBGx and is proposed as non-jurisdictional and is a constructed storm water pond noted in the City inventory as water quality pond. Basin P2 is a PUBG, shallow open water basin dominated by box elder, buckthorn, reed canary grass, and virgina creeper. Basin P3 is proposed as a non-jurisdictional PUBGx storm water pond dominated by willow, buckthorn, bluegrass, and poverty rush but is not noted as a water quality pond in the City inventory. Basin P4 is a PUBGx storm water pond and is noted in the City inventory as a water quality pond. The wetland boundaries, types, and jurisdictional statuses are approved as presented. It is noted that Basin P3 had no wetland characteristics until the 1970s when it appears it was excavated for drainage and excavated/expanded again in the 1980s to provide storage and rate control.

Wetlands may not be impacted until all applicable conditions have been met! Subp. 5 provides notice that a decision was made by the LGU under the Wetland Conservation Act as specified above. 
