 - Add goal under impaired waters to maintain or improve fish index of biologic integrity for applicable lakes.
 - Revise chloride issue statement to "High chloride loading from overuse of winter deicers across the Bassett Creek watershed negatively impacts lakes streams, and groundwater water quality."
 - B. Determine whether to increase the priority level from "medium" to "high" for the following issues: streambank and gully erosion, lakeshore erosion, education-related issues. (See pages 4-5 in the issues priority list.)
 - C. Determine if the term "priority lakes" refers to both priority 1 and priority 2 lakes in the goals text.
 - D. Determine if the PSC should revisit lake classifications that were developed for 2015 Plan. (See Appendix C)
- 4. REVIEW AND DISCUSS COMMISSION'S FUTURE IMPLEMENTATION CAPACITY attached with meeting materials Committee Member Welch and Administrator Jester would like feedback on the question of the Commission's staff capacity for implementing new and expanded strategies and actions being considered for this plan.
